PARENTS/GUARDIANS: Please read this information sheet! Concord Baptist Association Children's Camp July 15-18, 2019

CHILDREN'S CAMP is for those entering grades 4-7 next year.

<u>REGISTRATION:</u> Please complete the Registration/Medical Release form and sign in all places as indicated. Have your church mail the completed form to the Concord Baptist Association along with appropriate camp fees. <u>Registration is not complete until funds received.</u>

<u>CAMP FEES</u>: Children's camp is \$75 before July 10 and \$85 after. Families with more than one camper enrolled in children's camp will receive a \$10 discount for each <u>additional</u> camper if enrolled before the July 10 deadline. All fees are to be paid to the church.

<u>CAMP WEEK:</u> Each church is responsible for transportation to and from camp. On the beginning day of camp no lunch is served–<u>please eat before arrival</u>!

ARRIVAL & CHECK-OUT: Children's camp registration is between 2:00-2:30 p.m. Do not arrive before 2:00. Checkout time is following the worship service on Thursday night. Please be sure your child will be picked up promptly.

INJURY INSURANCE: Campers will be covered with ACCIDENT INSURANCE which pays only that not paid by your family policy. Campers are **not covered for sickness.** If treatment for sickness is needed, parents will be called and arrangements will be made. **The Medical/Permission Release Form MUST be completed by the parent or guardian.**

<u>WHAT TO BRING</u>: Needs are: Bible, notebook, pencil, bedding (pillow, sheets, twin size blow-up mattress or mat, blanket or sleeping bag), personal items (towels, toothbrush, soap, etc.) flashlight, 2 pairs of shoes, sports clothes, swimsuit, light jacket, jeans, etc. <u>All clothes should</u> be modest & appropriate for a Christian camp.

<u>WHAT NOT TO BRING</u>: No short shorts, tube-tops, two piece/cut-a-way swimsuits, offensive words or pictures, etc. No money is needed at camp, so please do not send any! No valuables, or extra candy or snacks are needed. No cell phones or electronic devices of any kind (iPods, handheld games, etc.). If brought, they will be collected and returned at the end of camp. NOTE: An emergency contact phone number will be provided when students check in. Parents are welcome to visit camp and participate in activities, but disruption of the camp experience is discouraged.

SPECIAL MEDICAL NEEDS: Campers who are taking medications and/or subject to diabetes or epilepsy must report to camp nurse upon arriving. The nurse will administer all medications which should be in original bottles with administration directions clearly marked. **The Medical/Permission Release Form MUST be completed by the parent or guardian.**

PERMISSION TO LEAVE CAMP: No child will be allowed to leave camp without advanced written permission by the parent or guardian who signed their registration form. Permission slips will be available by calling the association office (573-635-4832) or when campers check in on Monday.
