The vision team included: Pastor Ken McCune; Pastor Jared Rivera; Pastor Heber Mena and Director of Missions and Pastor Alan Earls. The Vision trip was considered a success and the CBA entered into an agreement with ABES to enter into a partnership mission agreement in April 2024.

Have you ever been discouraged in your personal witnessing? Have you ever had those thoughts of what is the use of telling a person over and over about Jesus? I have witnessed and talked to them about the Lord Jesus and it just seems as if it has fallen on deaf ears. I have prayed and prayed for an individual's soul for years and it hasn't seemed to have any impact on their attitude towards the things of God. Let me encourage you to keep on keeping on for the Lord.

I received a text from a friend this past week that encouraged and at the same time challenged me. This lady volunteers in a ministry I am involved in. She told me a few years ago that her dad was lost. He was getting up in age and she was really burdened for him. He had never trusted Jesus as his personal Lord and Savior. She said she had witnessed to him several times and that several preachers had shared the gospel with him, but he had never surrendered his life to the Lord Jesus Christ. I prayed with her about her dad's salvation and told her that as the Lord brought him to my mind I would be in prayer for his salvation.

I want to share with you a message she sent me right as I was going into a church to preach on a Sunday evening:

"Hi Mike! Couldn't wait to let you know my Dad walked to the front at church this morning and gave his heart to the Lord. He was truly touched by the Holy Spirit and had tears in his eyes as he prayed to receive Jesus as his Savior. I am praising God! I have prayed for him since I was a little girl."

Isn't God good! What a mighty God we serve! When I read that text, my mind went to the verse that says, "And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart" (Galatians 6:9).

By the way I almost forgot to tell you, her dad is 94 years old!

# Life is Funny Until It's Not

A Comic's Story of Love, Loss, and Lunacy By Chonda Pierce

Chonda Pierce is a popular Christian comedian whose humor and unique outlook on life has brought laughter to our lives for years. In this book, she gives us a glimpse of the person behind the laughter. Her story will grip you, break your heart, and remind you that the person we see onstage is never the whole story.

Chonda's father was a preacher, and also an abusive, untreated manic-depressive, and borderline schizophrenic. Reconciling the great dad he could be with the abusive, troubled one who appeared periodically, impacted her entire childhood and into her adult years.

Chonda was born the middle child with two sisters and one brother. She describes herself as "rebellious and independent," (Pierce 2024, p.1). Chonda learned early that if she could make her mother laugh when she was mad then she got into less trouble. She attributes this fact to her later success onstage.

Chonda is open and honest about her loss and the financial and marital struggles in her life. She also shares about the spiritual struggles experienced along the way and the role her faith played in moving past the ugliness of life. "My faith is the power that helps me deal with my pain," (Pierce 2024, p.158).



Chonda Pierce's story reminds us that even in the dark places of life, God is there, He has a plan, and He offers us hope. I enjoyed this book and highly recommend it. As you read, go look up some of her comedy videos, not only for laughs but for a reminder of the goodness of God.




